A Veterans Home is being built in Southern Utah. A 10 acre parcel of land has been donated to the Utah Department of Veterans' Affairs for this purpose, by the city of Ivins. The State Of Utah's share is 35% of the cost and the National Department of Veterans Affairs share is the other 65%. The facility will have 108 rooms for Veterans and will provide all services as an up-scale Nursing Home would provide. The rooms will be equipped with average furnishings. In order to upgrade the furnishings with top of the line furnishings including a TV it will take an additional \$4,000 per room. In the Ogden, Utah Veterans' Home many organizations and companies took on the obligation of sponsoring a room. A plaque was placed on the door of the room they sponsored. In some cases the room would be in honor of an individual.

For every \$35.00 dollars that is raised prior to July 15, 2011 the National Department of Veterans will match it with an additional \$65. After July 15th there is no match from the National.
