WHEREAS, The close association of The American Legion, The Armed Forces and veterans of both the United States and Republic of Korea, through both business, political, and principle ties, and

WHEREAS, The ongoing demand for mutual obligation in the form of supplies, manpower and cooperation in their struggles to combat tyrannical regimes, and

WHEREAS, The National Organization of The American Legion by and through its National Executive Committee have established similar relationships with our allies; Canada, Great Britain and Chinese Taipei; and

WHEREAS, These Associations have brought great friendship, mutual respect, and honor to its members and

WHEREAS, The government of the Republic of Korea and its citizenry are in support of such an association, and

WHEREAS, The Government of the United States, through its continued alliance, support defense and close political and entrepreneurial relationships with the Republic of Korea, and

WHEREAS, The development of such an organization would further enhance these close associations; therefore be it

RESOLVED, We support the Development and Ongoing support of the Republic of Korea Veterans, Armed Forces, United States Unit, and be it further
